

Directions to Pinnacle Campground:

From the North; take Southbound Hwy 101 to the Hollister Hwy 25 exit. Follow signs for Pinnacles National Monument through town and continue on Hwy 25 for 30 miles to Hwy 146 .

From the South; take Northbound Hwy 101 to the first King City exit. You'll stay on this same road for 15 miles until you reach Hwy 25 to Hiway 146 then turn left.

We are adjacent to the EAST entrance of Pinnacles National Monument.
HIWAY 146 DOES NOT GO THRU the monument from HIWAY 101

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

Please read the following completely.

Sunday thru Friday check in and out is 3 p.m. saturday check in and out is 11:00 a.m.
Late check out will result in additional charges.

If you are making reservations for several people please make sure everyone is aware of our rules. Please stop and check in at the store upon arrival if we are not open when you come in please return to the store during our business hours.

Our cancellation policy is 7 days in advance (30 days for group sites)for a refund of camping fees.(no exceptions) the reservation fee is non refundable plus there is a \$7.00 fee for canceling (total of \$14.00)(for group site refunds please see the website for fees) there is also a \$7.00 change fee for any changes to your reservation (PEOPLE, DATES, SITES ETC.).

Radios (or other amplified sounds) and generators are not allowed at any time in the campground

Quiet hours are 10pm to 8am.

10 m.p.h. speed limit everywhere on the property,

Parking is only allowed in your driveway area please do not park in the grass or move barriers . Wood fires are now being allowed (per the national park service).

All dogs (are \$3.00 ea) must be leashed at all times and cannot be left unattended in the campground at any time
