As the Troop Historian of the Piedmont Boy Scout Council's Troop 11, I will be especially mindful of conducting myself by the Scout Oath, Scout Law, Scout Motto and Scout Slogan.

I will lead by example and make these commitments to my fellow scouts, the scoutmasters and myself. I will:

1. Report my activities and progress to the Assistant Senior Patrol Leader (ASPL) at least once a month.
2. Actively recruit and collect photos from troop activities (obtain them from people who went on the outings and took pictures). Ask for pictures, don't wait for them to come to you.
3. Write one article per month about a troop outing, special event, or Court of Honor. This article should be accompanied with pictures and delivered in digital form to the Troop Librarian, ASPL, and Scoutmaster for review and archiving.
4. Once per school semester (or scout half-season), create a poster with one of your articles and accompanying pictures on it. Deliver this to the troop Librarian.
5. Once per school semester (or scout half-season), have a troop related article published in a local newspaper. Deliver the article to the troop ASPL, SPL, and Scoutmaster for review prior to submission to the paper.
6. Attend, be on time and ready for meetings and troop activities, and tell the Assistant Senior Patrol Leader (ASPL) as soon as I know that I can't make a meeting or event.
7. Have fun and help other scouts have fun too!
