As the Quartermaster of the Piedmont Boy Scout Council's Troop 11, I will be especially mindful of conducting myself by the Scout Oath, Scout Law, Scout Motto and Scout Slogan. I will lead by example and make these commitments to my fellow scouts, the scoutmasters and myself. I will:

1. Report my activities and progress to the Assistant Senior Patrol Leader (ASPL) at least once a month.
2. Update the equipment inventory report.
3. Keep the Senior Patrol Leader informed of all important equipment needs and information.
4. Suggest new equipment and needed replacements to the ASPL, and help buy new equipment with an appropriate Troop adult.
5. Ensure that Troop equipment is clean, in good condition and neat in the Troop's storage space.
6. Coordinate the allocation, collection, inspection and re-stowing of Troop equipment to the patrols for all outings; keep list of equipment in each patrol.
7. Label equipment and shelves, as needed.
8. Attend the Patrol Leaders Council (PLC) meetings.
9. Be on time and ready for meetings and Troop activities, and tell the ASPL as soon as I know that I can't make a meeting or event.
10. Wear the proper uniform with the Quartermaster Patch at all Troop meetings and events.
11. Help other scouts whenever possible and be especially supportive of younger and less experienced scouts.
12. Have fun and help other scouts have fun too!
